KEY SCHOOL FEATURES

FHS serves mostly West Side Columbus high school students in grades 9 - 12.

The school offers a traditional high school experience. The day begins with a common Morning Meeting. Class sizes in core subjects and in Arts & Movement classes are small. Mastery learning in these classes is emphasized. Weekly Advisory class is focused on career pathways, and student wellness. Faculty meet twice a week in Collaborative Planning to maintain school focus. The After-School 21st Century Program focuses on expanded Youth Development experiences, including athletics.

North Central Ohio Educational Service Center is FHS SPONSOR. They provide educational support services and oversight to its community schools. This includes opportunities for professional development, providing technical assistance, assuring compliance with state expectations, and setting performance and accountability standards for its schools relating to academic programs, operational and legal compliance, and finances.
